Raúl thinks that his father was murdered by the mafia, to whom Nacho owed a lot of money. Maria del Carmen and Estrella were ready to move on with their lives until a police officer investigating Nacho's disappearance knocked on their door. Now, the Calderón family is gathered in the living room, ready to answer questions from the authorities. O-M-G! My palms are sweaty...Mom's spaghetti... let's go!

INT. LA CASA ROSA - NIGHT 34.1

General murmuring/Overlapping

LUISA

Gloria fix your makeup

RAÚL

What is this about?

ESTEBAN

//I really don't have much time for this

ESTRELLA

I'm just...dusting...Like normal

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Please everyone, have a seat. Buenas noches, and thank you for meeting us at such an inconvenient time. I would like to introduce my new partner, Officer Hausmann.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

(Very stiff)

Mucho gusto.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Obviamente, we're here in regards to Nacho's disappearance. Raúl, good to see you. I have you in my prayers during this difficult time.

RAÚL

Muchas gracias, Officer Gómez, truth is it's been...

OFFICER HAUSMANN

(Cutting him off)

Sí, sí. Given that all of you are the closest people associated with Nacho, we wanted to ask you some questions.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

(Abashed)

hehe sí, but I just want to make it clear that this is a formality more than anything else and that nobody here is being seriously considered as a suspect. //

OFFICER HAUSMANN

(Cutting him off)

Well, it's still a little too early to rule anyone out. Right now we're just trying to gather all the facts and find out exactly what happened.

ESTEBAN

¿Officer Hassmen?

OFFICER HAUSMANN

HOUSE-MAN.

ESTEBAN

¿Hoosemen?

OFFICER HAUSMANN

HOUSE-MAN.

ESTEBAN

Yes, of course, Hausmann. Well, I think you will find us to be perfectly cooperative. We have nothing to hide. Officer Gomez and I have been friends for over twenty years and he can confirm that, despite our public persona, we are just a regular, boring American family.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Yes, Esteban, I already told my partner that you are all model citizens and we appreciate your cooperation. This is just protocol, you know?

OFFICER HAUSMANN

It's not just protocol. Señor Calderón, you're in the middle of a mayoral race, right?

ESTEBAN

Yes, that's right, officer HOUSE-MEN.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

(Annoyed but lets it go)

A very close race as I understand it. And Nacho, as your campaign manager, would have access to all of your most personal documents. Including any that you might want to keep secret, no?

ESTEBAN

Bueno, I wouldn't say that //

OFFICER HAUSMANN

(Cutting him off)

And Gloria, up until recently, you were engaged with Raúl, Nacho's son, isn't that right?

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

Uh, sí, that's correct.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

A relationship that ended somewhat abruptly and in a very public manner. I'm sure that Nacho wasn't too happy about that...

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

Sí, but I don't//

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Y Luisa - isn't it true that you and Nacho always had a very tense and confrontational relationship?

LUISA

Who? Me? Yes, I mean, we weren't BEST friends but I certainly didn't kill the man.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Who said anything about Nacho being murdered?

RAÚL

You think my Papi was murdered?

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Let's settle down here. We all have a history with Nacho here. I myself have gotten a little tipsy with the man on occasion. Lest we forget the Chuck E Cheese incident.

(Laughs)

OFFICER HAUSMANN

(Clears throat)

OFFICER GÓMEZ

But there's no need to air out dirty laundry...

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Funny you should mention that, because that's exactly what I want to do. I think there's a lot to talk about here, so, why don't we split up? I'll interrogate, I mean, have a chat with Esteban in the study and you can start with Gloria and Luisa in the kitchen.

A silence.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Did I stutter? Come on, let's get this moving.

The family starts grumbling and shuffling out.

ESTEBAN

(Whispering)

Oye, Gómez, what's her deal? I thought I paid you to keep me out of this sort of thing...

OFFICER GÓMEZ

(Whispering)

She's a transfer and she's trying to make a name for herself. Don't worry, I'll make sure that nothing gets out of hand.

(Loudly)

Bueno, Gloria, why don't we go to the kitchen and talk for a bit?

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

(Nervously)

Por supuesto, this way.

[Musical Transition]

INT. STUDY - NIGHT 34.2

ESTEBAN

Welcome to my study, officer.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Bueno, señor Calderón, let's start with something simple: Where were you on the night of Nacho's disappearance?

ESTEBAN

(Pouring himself a drink)

Whiskey?

OFFICER HAUSMANN

No, gracias. I don't drink.

ESTEBAN

Like, ever? Really? You're such a charming woman, one would imagine that you'd be going out for drinks with eligible bachelors every night.//

OFFICER HAUSMANN

(Cutting him off)

//Can we not? Answer my question, Señor Calderón?

ESTEBAN

Ah sí, I forgot, what was it again?

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Where were you the night of Nacho's disappearance?

ESTEBAN

What day was it? Thursday? Bueno, I think I was working overnight at the office. As you well know, I'm running for mayor so there's always something that needs my attention.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Is there anyone who could corroborate your alibi?

ESTEBAN

Oh, I don't know, just hundreds of Miami's eligible voters. You see, so close to the election, it's important to speak directly to constituents to make sure that they understand where I stand on certain topics. So every night this week I've been personally calling voters from my office.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

And you were doing this alone? There was no one else with you at the office?

ESTEBAN

My assistant was there until 8 pm, but I stayed until the wee hours.

She scribbles in her notepad

ESTEBAN

What are you writing?

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Why don't you tell me a little bit about your relationship with Nacho?

ESTEBAN

(Chokes on his drink)

What relationship? I don't know what relationship you're referring to.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Aren't you two close friends? His son was about to marry your daughter. He was your campaign manager. How was the relationship between you two?

ESTEBAN

Ah, sí, bueno, THAT relationship. I wouldn't say that we're CLOSE. We're friendly... we get along... more business partners than anything else

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Ah huh. When we ran a trace on Nacho's credit cards, we saw that he booked a room for a night in a hotel downtown. Do you happen to know who he was meeting there?

ESTEBAN

...I wasn't aware of that. No, em, I'd have to check my calendar and see if...

OFFICER HAUSMANN

In the days before Mr. Santana's disappearance, did you notice anything out of the ordinary?

ESTEBAN

Sorry? What do you mean?

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Anything unusual, like his behavior or...

ESTEBAN

(Feeling pressured and cornered)

Well, ehm. Yeah.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Why do I get the sense you are hiding something?

ESTEBAN

I don't know much because I didn't want to get involved... you know, political implications and all that. But he did mention that he owed money to... someone...

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Someone? What were his exact words?

GLORIA (VO)

Uh oh, Esteban, seems like Maria isn't the only one hoping the Mafia takes the fall for this one. Let's see how Maria and Luisa are doing with Officer Gomez.

INT. KITCHEN - NIGHT 34.3

SFX a wrapper crumpling. A light vacuuming in the background

OFFICER GÓMEZ

(Licking his fingers)

MMM wow. Delicioso. Luisa, this calzone is amazing. Your folded pizzas are unparalleled.

LUISA

I ordered it.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Ah! Bueno, then your taste in delivery is outstanding.

LUISA

Um... weren't you going to ask us questions?

Vacuuming becomes louder.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Jeje sí, sí, l suppose l

(Shouting over the vacuum)

I suppose I should ask//

LUISA

(Snappy)

Estrella, could you maybe vacuum SOME OTHER TIME?

ESTRELLA

AY, perdón! Of course, I'll just focus on dusting for a bit.

LUISA

This might be the first time I've actually seen her clean the place.

(Sighs)

Bueno, your questions, Officer Gómez?

OFFICER GÓMEZ

(Very serious suddenly)

Sí, sí. Question number one: which one of you killed Nacho Santana?

A silence.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

НАНАНАНАНАА.

The rest nervously begin to laugh as well.

Ah! I'm joking, I'm joking. You seriously don't think I'm going to ask you about any of this, do you?

I don't know if this is the appropriate time for jokes...

(Ignoring her)

Luisa, we've known each other for 20 years. There's no way I'd suspect you. Besides, if you were having someone killed, don't you think I'd know?

Everyone laughs good-naturedly.

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

HILARIOUS. What a funny joke. You made it. Very funny.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Bueno, all I need to know is what you guys were doing the night that Nacho went missing. ¿Gloria?

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

I was... I was, um...Uhhhhhh

ESTRELLA

YOU WERE IN PRACTICE. BAND PRACTICE.

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

YES. AND. ehm, I hadn't mentioned anything about it because we're still practicing... Pero así es, I was at band practice.

LUISA

You're in a BAND?

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Ah, muy bien, can any of your bandmates corroborate your story? Who are the members of this band?

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

Uh...

ESTRELLA

ME! It's me. Just Gloria and ME, Estrella. I guess it's more of a duo than a band. Pero, pues, the White Stripes are a band and they're only two... so, yeah! You know what? We are a band!

LUISA

Gloria, I told you not to get too close to the help.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

(Scribbling notes)

Muy bien! Investigation done! And Luisa - I'll just assume you were home.

Only Estrella laughs. It peters out awkwardly. The door opens.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Gómez, I'm ready. Are you guys ready?

OFFICER GÓMEZ

We just finished. I'll be right out.

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Está bien.

SFX The door shuts.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Gloria, you're a very talented young lady. Follow those musical dreams! You know I was in a band once? Good times.

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

(Weirded out)

Gracias, Oficial Gómez.

Everyone gets up and starts walking to the door.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Ah, and before I forget. How's that surprise you were planning for your father?

LUISA

¿Qué?

OFFICER GÓMEZ

The surprise party for Esteban. The other night I pulled Gloria over, and she was on her way to pick up something for the party. I'm still waiting for my invitation...Oye, and whatever happened to that Ferrari? I didn't see it out front.

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

Oh, the car I was driving, um... I took it back to the dealership. It wasn't my style.

OFFICER GÓMEZ

Ah, qué pena. It was a hot ride. Bueno, can't wait for that invitation

LUISA

(Suspicious)

Of course, Officer Gómez. Gloria, how very thoughtful of you.

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

Haha, thanks mom. You know me, always thinking of others

GLORIA (VO)

Looks like Maria may have gotten past the police, but Luisa smells something off...

[Musical Transition]

EXT. LA CASA ROSA - NIGHT 34.4

Crickets chirp as they get into their squad car. The door to the house opens and closes and footsteps run-up to the car.

RAÚL

Wait! Officers, wait!

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Raúl - I thought you'd left.

RAÚL

Officer, what do you know about my father? Do you have any leads?

OFFICER HAUSMANN

It's too early to tell. And the case is still ongoing so I can't really share any information with you at the moment.

RAÚL

(Dejected)

Sí, bueno, I understand. Muchas gracias.

He starts walking away

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Hey Raul. Wait a second. Look, I don't know what happened to your father, but what I do know is that someone in that house is lying.

RAÚL

What?

OFFICER HAUSMANN

Just do me a favor, be very careful, Raúl. People close to Esteban have a tendency to disappear. Your father isn't the first one. If you need anything, here's my card. Give me a call. Stay Safe.

The patrol car door shuts. Raúl's footsteps head back to the house.

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

Raúl, are you ok? - You look pale.

RAÚL

Gloria - I know we're not on the best of terms right now, but I need a friend, and I know I can trust you.

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

Of course, what is it?

RAÚL

I think ... I think that Esteban might have murdered my dad...

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

(Whispering)

WHAT?! What do you mean?

RAÚL

I never would have even thought of it, but the police just told me that they suspect him. And then there's the blackmail thing my dad was looking into...Gloria, I don't know what to think.

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

What did the police say?

RAÚL

That it's not the first time that someone close to Esteban disappears. They told me to be careful. When my dad disappeared I immediately assumed it was the guys who beat me up - the ones he owed money to. But, what if it wasn't them? What if it's someone I know who did this?

(Pause)

What am I saying? ... Esteban doesn't have any reason to harm my dad... I have to figure this out myself. I'm gonna find out who is responsible if it's the last thing I do.

He starts to walk away

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

WAIT. Maybe you're right. What if there was a motive... What if your dad knew something about Esteban that he didn't want to be made public? A secret.

RAÚL

Gloria, what are you saying?

MARÍA DEL CARMEN

Raúl - there's a video I need you to see ...

GLORIA (VO)

WHOA BOMBSHELL. María del Carmen, you really have changed. But is this scheme gonna let you off the hook, or pull you in deeper?....
